Conference Dress Code

Adherence to the following dress code is not a recommendation, but a mandatory requirement that applies to all participants. **Those who do not comply will not be admitted to the General Assembly Hall.**

Men are expected to wear a suit or dress pants accompanied by a jacket, dress shoes, and collared shirt with a tie.

Women are expected to wear either dress pants or a knee-high skirt/dress accompanied by a shirt/blouse and dress shoes.

Please do not wear any of the following on either day of the UNIS-UN Conference:

- Jeans, Sneakers, Hats
- Baggy or ripped clothing
- Sweatpants or athletic attire

Additionally, security is expected to move even more slowly than usual this year, as another conference will be in session at the same time as ours. To speed things up, please:

- Do not bring any large bags or backpacks to the United Nations. They will not be allowed inside.
- Avoid carrying or wearing any metal objects and electronic devices (belts, Discman, MP3 Players, etc).

*Strict adherence to this dress code is required from all participants.
Students will face disciplinary action for non-compliance.*
